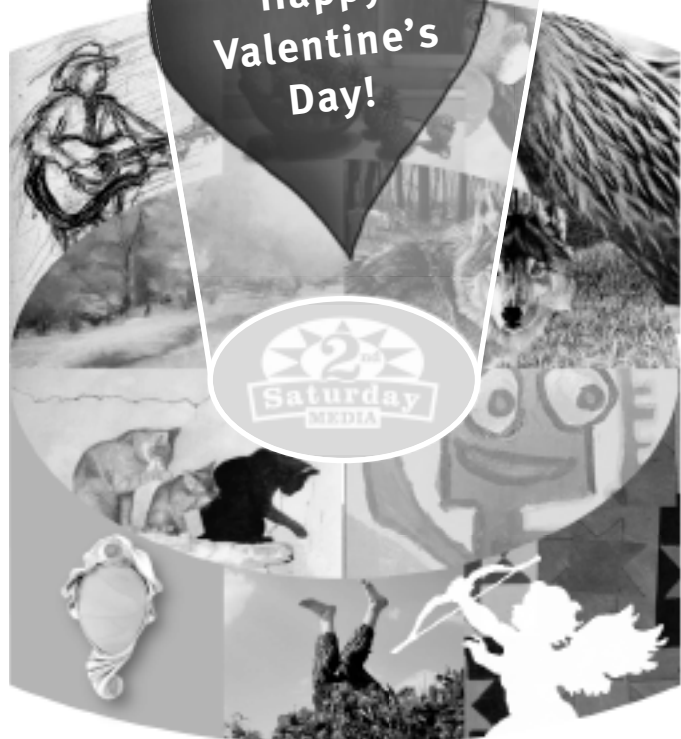

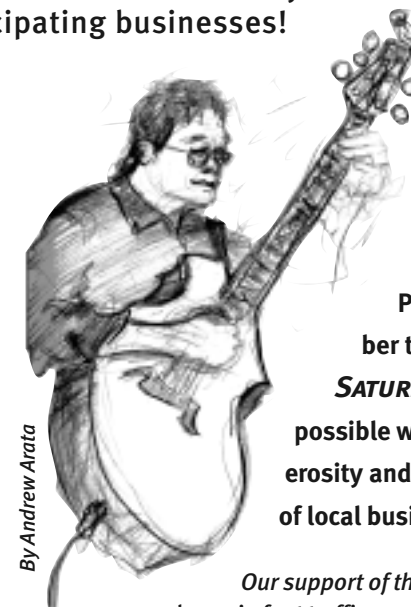

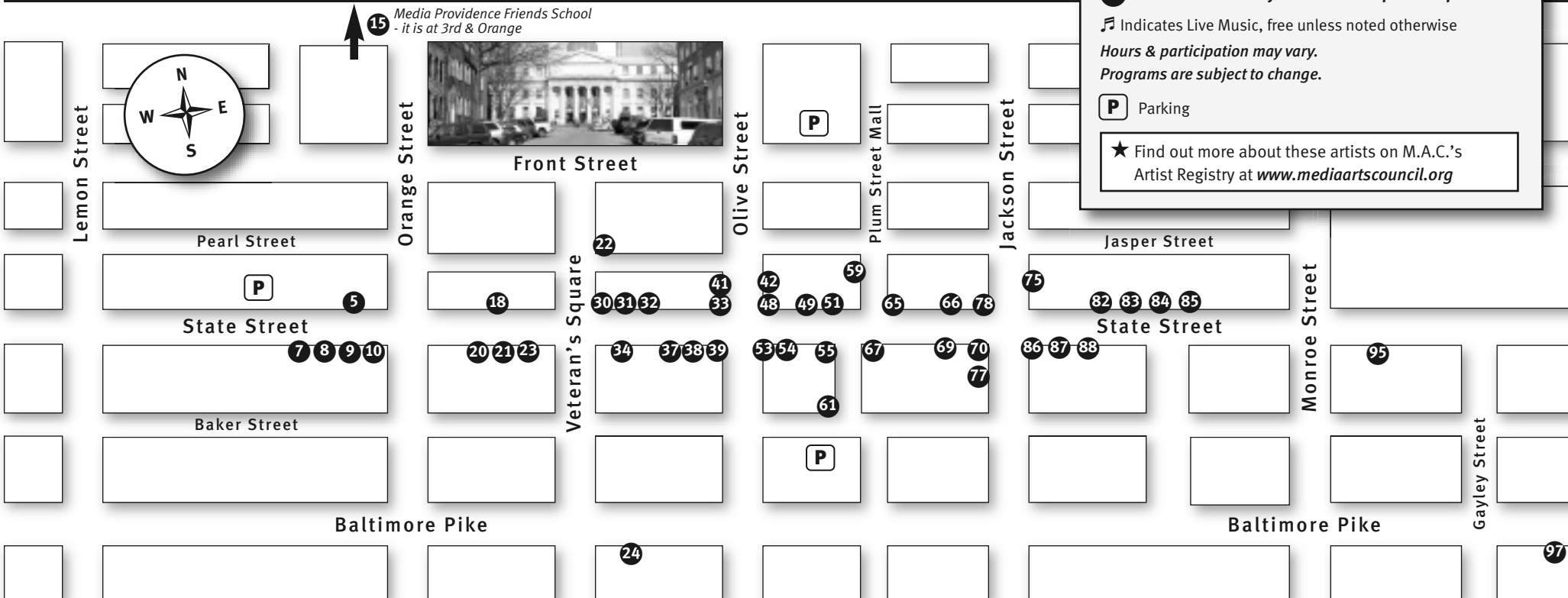

Cost is \$2/person and less.

Schedule during Second Saturday:

Orange Street: 6:04, 6:34, 7:04, 7:38, 8:12, 8:45 - heading East

Providence Road: 5:54, 6:23, 6:53, 7:29, 8:03, 8:33 - heading West
